- To study BBS, the entrance test [CMAT](#) is not mandatory. Students who have passed 10+2 or equivalent examinations from the recognized academic institutes with second division (securing 45% and above) or 1.8 CGPA are eligible to enroll in BBS program.

Applicant should submit the following documents at the time of admission:

- Complete and signed admission form along with an application fee
- Official copy of academic certificates (SLC onwards)
- Copy of a character certificate issued by the school
- Copy of a character certificate issued by the College
- Copy of citizenship card

Scholarship

- Scholarships are awarded up to 100% on the merit basis and needy basis.

CURRICULAR STRUCTURE

Each student must pass 22 courses to earn Four-Year B.Ed. These courses are divided into four major groups - group 'A' with Communication Skills; group 'B' with Professional Cores Areas; group 'C' with Specialization Major Courses and group 'D' with Specialization Minor Courses. Group 'E' includes Teaching Practice/Practicum.

Group A: Communication Skills

All courses under this group are compulsory.

- Philosophical and Sociological Foundations of Education
- Educational Psychology
- Curriculum and Evaluation

- Elective (Any one of the following subjects)

- Health and Physical Education
- Population Education
- Economics Education

Group C: Specialization Major

Students are required to select one of the following specialization areas with 10 courses in each area considering entry requirement.

- Nepali Language Education
- English Language Education
- Math Education
- Health and Physical Education
- Population Education
- Economics Education

Group D: Specialization Minor

Students are required to select one of the following specialization areas with 5 courses. But it should be different from specialization major. For example, a student majoring Nepali cannot select Nepali as minor. Specially, student majoring Science Education (Physical Science) must select biology as minor subject.

Evaluation and Grading System of BBS

The BBS students need to fulfil these requirements:

- The successful completion of 19 courses of 1950 marks and submit a final project report of 50 marks as prescribed with passing grades in all the courses.
- The passing scores were obtained separately in all theory and practical components of the courses.
- Completion of courses to fulfil the BBS programme must occur within the time limit as prescribed by Tribhuvan University.

There will be an internal and final evaluation to analyze students' performance.

Final Evaluation

The Office of the Controller of Examinations conducts the final evaluation via Annual examinations. Students can only appear on the final examination if they satisfy these criteria:

- Record a minimum of 70% attendance during the classes
- No student will be allowed to appear in the second-year final examinations without first appearing in the first-year final examinations.

Grading System

The final examination/ annual examination follows this grading system.
